## Bushey's Multifaith Mile: New Muslim Community Centre Launched in Bushey, joining Christian, Jewish and Jain Community Centres.

Bushey's Multifaith Mile is already home to a significant community of Bahá'ís, Christians, Hindus, Jains and other faiths, who have found Bushey to be a welcoming home for many decades. The addition of the Bushey Islamic Circle enriches this spiritual melting pot, fostering a spirit of unity and shared purpose among the diverse residents.

A long-time Bushey resident, who has lived in the town for 35 years, shared their excitement:

"I have lived in Bushey for 35 years and have never seen The Bushey Centre being utilised the way it is now. It is refreshing to see a building being used no less than 5 times a day and offering a variety of activities to all. The Bushey Country Club has been home to many businesses and activities for several decades but over the past few years has gone on to be the home for an established car wash, boxing gym, restaurant and café, a dance school and now an educational centre for local Muslims. It really is refreshing to see how diverse the community is."

The establishment of the BIC is a testament to Bushey's commitment to fostering a community spirit that integrates, supports, and celebrates its diverse population.



As BIC opens its doors, it not only serves the Muslim community but also invites collaboration and participation from all of Bushey's residents, ensuring that Bushey remains a beacon of unity and pride.
